The April issue of **The Whole Truth is available today**. The deadline for the May issue, which will be published Easter Sunday, is April 17th (please note: that is a couple days early).



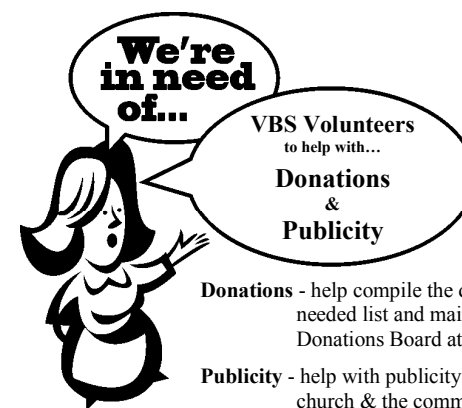
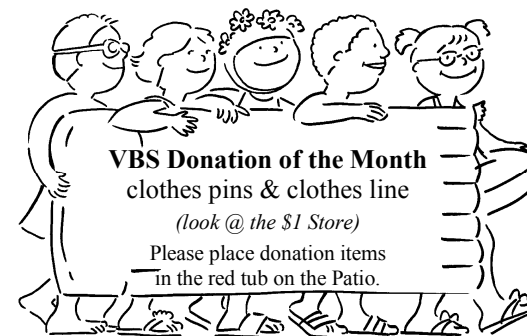
EASTER FLOWERS
